DELTA SKATING CLUB - Junior Development Program

An introductory figure skating program for skaters who have completed the first three CanSkate Stages 1 – 3 and who demonstrate potential beyond the recreational level. **Junior Development** is the next stage for skaters to bridge the gap between CanSkate group lessons and StarSkate Programs when skaters begin private lessons in preparation for competitions and Skate Canada Tests. The program introduces skaters to freeskate, skating skills & dance. The class is divided into groups based ability with a max. of 10 skaters in each group with one Skate Canada coach per group.
